- Two divisions only (Jr. Miss and Miss, must qualify age-wise on day of pageant no younger divisions);
- Pate: Monday evening, Sept. 9, 2019;
 - Time: Jr. Miss Pageant begins at 6:00PM, Miss immediately to follow;
- Scholarship Pageant Miss Queen will advance to state competition;
- Entry fee: \$50.00;
- Crown, sash and flowers and additional prizes TBA;
- Entry materials given at the organizational meeting, parents urged to attend.

Junior Miss Washington County

This pageant, a traditional and important part of the Washington County Fair, is proudly sponsored again in 2019 by the Fair Board of Directors and Committee and supported by local businesses and interested individuals. Queens in each of the two (2) categories will receive a crown, trophy, sash and roses. Each will be crowned on Monday night of the Fair and will be introduced any/all nights during the remainder of the Fair, through Saturday, Sept. fourteenth (14th). The numbers of runners-up will be determined once the officials are assured of the number of participants. The runners-up chosen for each category receive a trophy, roses and cash prize. Cash prizes to be awarded in both divisions are: Queen \$100.00; 1st runner-up \$50.00; 2nd runner-up \$25.00.

Miss Washington County 2019 will have the opportunity, and hereby agrees accordingly, to participate in the Miss Virginia Fair Association Pageant in January, 2020 at the Homestead Resort in Hot Springs, Virginia.

AGE DIVISIONS

Junior Miss: Contestants must be at least 12 but no older than 15 by the date of the pageant.

Miss Washington County: Contestants must be at least 16 but no older than 22 by the date of the pageant.

GENERAL PAGEANT REGULATIONS & INFORMATION

In order to be eligible to participate in this pageant, each contestant <u>must</u> meet the following criteria:

- 1. Be a female resident (or student) of one of the localities in Virginia, named above;
- 2. Be single (never married, never pregnant and without children);
- Meet all requirements of registration, sponsorship and/or payment of fees by the deadline, Aug. 23, 2019, 5:00 pm.

Contestants are required to wear a long or tea-length gown and model throughout the various rounds of the pageant. Contestants will be judged on natural beauty and appearance, personality (as evidenced by self-introduction and on-stage questions) and modeling ability/ self-confidence. In an effort to comply more closely with the State competition requirements and enhance the opportunity for our own contestants, Miss Washington County contestants (ages 16-21 only) will be required to participate in an interview process as part of the overall pageant process this year. The interview competition will be held on Sunday afternoon, Sept. 9, the day prior to the pageant. Interviews will be randomly assigned and will be conducted beginning at 1:00 PM at the Fairgrounds building on Sunday afternoon, September 9. This is new to our local pageant and will constitute .33% of the total score utilized in the determination of the 2019 Queen and her court. Interviews will last for approximately seven (7) minutes and will be judged by a separate panel of independent judges. Because of the increased need for additional planning, the deadline for applications is Friday, August 23 2019. at 5:00 PM. We (Miss Contestants only) will meet at that time at the fairgrounds facility for a short question/answer session to prepare each contestant for her respective interview. Late entries will not be accepted – please do not ask for time extensions.

Jr. Miss contestants will not participate in the formal interview process. Junior Miss contestants should arrive at the Fairgrounds no later than 6:00 on September 9. Limited dressing area will be provided. The pageant portion of the Miss Washington County pageant will immediately follow the Jr. Miss pageant.

Contestants in both divisions are expected to exhibit courtesy above reproach, and will agree to remain through the duration of the events to demonstrate courtesy and respect for the pageant and its contestants.

Rehearsal/Orientation for Jr. Miss contestants will be held at the Fairgrounds on Sunday Sept. 8 beginning at 4:00 PM.

<u>Contestants</u> are admitted free to the Fairgrounds the evening of the pageant, all others are charged regular admission fee.

Both Queens are requested and expected to attend the Fair each remaining evening wearing sash and crown in order to be introduced by the talent act on the stage and attend other events. Both Queens and their respective Courts must agree to represent the Fair by riding the Queen's float in both the Fair

parade held in Abingdon as arranged by officials as well as in the Abingdon Christmas Parade and Town Christmas Tree lighting held in November.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Officers and Directors of The Washington County Fair reserve the right to alter any/all age divisions or regulations if it is necessary to do so in the best interests of the pageant.
